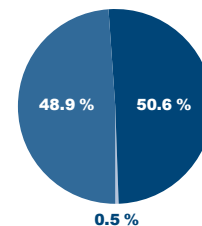

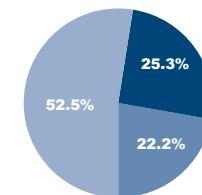

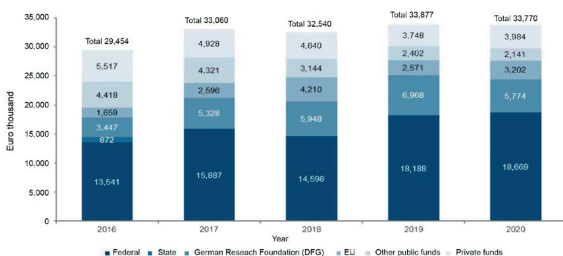

Third-party funds in the last 5 years according to source

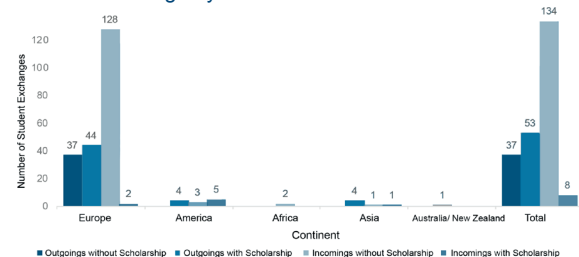

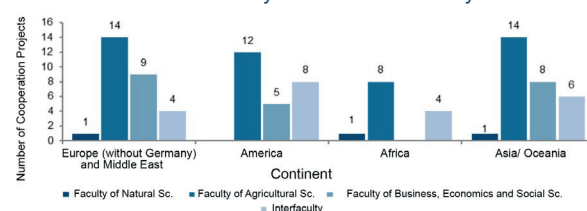
